HISTORY

Al-Taqwa University is a nationally acclaimed institution of higher education in Afghanistan. Quality education aimed at directing the students towards research, innovation and extension is the defining element of ATIHE. Al-Taqwa University, recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education of Afghanistan as one of the best higher education institutions in the country and makes history by becoming the private higher education institute officially registered with the Government of Afghanistan in the year 2012.

Since its inception, AIHE has grown from an initial enrollment of 150 students to more than 320 students in less than a few months. Today it is a thriving academic and intellectual center dedicated to providing Afghans with a world-class education programs. A non-profit, co-educational institution, ATIHE offers bachelor's degree programs in Economics, Business Administration, Law and Political Science. Al-Taqwa University also offers diploma programs in Information Technology (DIT) and English Language (DEL). The institute now has around 4000 students in all four bachelor's programs with more than 3000 Alumni.

Curriculum Innovation Process

The Curriculum Innovation Process (CIP) is a series of annual data-informed conversations with Academic Units on their:

- Program and course design and efficiency
- Student engagement, satisfaction and graduate outcomes
- Teaching-research alignment
- Academic workforce
- Teaching facilities.

The CIP is a key response to the challenges laid out in the local & regional job markets. It is also reflected in AU Strategic Action Plan 2021-2025 and seeks to:

- Take a whole of enterprise view of disciplines that underpin our curriculum including alignment with our research strengths, the quality of our facilities, and future workforce needs
- Improve student satisfaction, student retention, and graduate employment (assessed on statistics) particularly in our key discipline areas
- Enhance teaching quality through supporting and developing our academic workforce
- Ensure that adequate resources are available to sustain unique programs in areas of future workforce need and those that are of strategic value to the institution and the community
- Enhance awareness of key discipline areas to improve demand for our programs
- Improve the quality and consistency of blended delivery to enhance the flexibility of our curriculum for our students.

Each year, a series of actions and strategic priorities are identified through the CIP for academic and central units to lead, and these are incorporated in local area and university support plans. A number of major university-wide strategic projects have also emanated from the CIP.



RESEARCH FOCUS

The University of Al-Taqwa is one of Afghanistan's top research-intensive universities, addressing many of the cultural, economic and social challenges facing the country and the world today. At AU, our researchers are thought leaders and change makers. We have big ideas and we ask big questions. We translate our discoveries into solutions that benefit our economy and society. Alumni Relations:


